Committees:

For youth night kids who wear their KOU jersey receive free admission and a ticket for a free hot dog and drink. At half time the kids will be announced on the field for some additional fun!

We will try not to have too many of these, but they are an easy way to get people out to support the girls in a somewhat effortless way. - End of the Year Banquet: 11/10 at Napoli Restaurant. Jessica Dobson is the chair for this event but looking for others to help. This event is NOT combined with the boys. For the banquet we'll need someone to do a cookie table, lead the decorations, help prepare gifts for the team and more!

#### Treasurer's Report

We have a list of things that we're getting the girls for their season gear. This includes a sweatshirt, sweatpants, raincoat, and engraved Stanleys. Along with purchasing of gifts for the team, we have other events like the picnic, senior recognition night, tournaments, team banquet and many other expenses that start to add up over time. This is where fundraising comes into play.

## Fundraising:

- Sponsorships: We have already received a lot of money through sponsorships from Capital Construction, Mike & Tony's, Dormont Fire Department, Chick Fil A, Dormont Police Association and the VFW Post 694. If you know anyone / business interested in sponsoring the team, please share the sponsor letter with them or share their information with us and we can reach out.
- Concession Stands Volunteers: We need people to volunteer for concessions. The girls families volunteer for the boys games and vice versa so that no one needs to miss a game. The link is on the website under the parent tab. We are asking that each family volunteer for two concession stand days. When you volunteer, we also ask that you bring a dish to sell. Popular items are pierogies, Buffalo Chicken dip, Pizza, Haluski, meatballs. There are no rules, have fun with what you bring, we're known to have great offerings for the games!  
Note: the time for sign up is arrival time (30 minutes before kick off)
- 50/50: In addition to Concessions volunteers we are asking for people to do 50/50 sales during the games. This volunteer link is matched up with the concessions volunteer's sign-up genius.
- Lottery Ticket Sale Fundraiser: We'll do this again with the boys. Tickets are going to be sold at \$20 a each. Each ticket will have 2 numbers and 500 tickets will be sold (250 from the girls team and 250 from the boys team). If the number hits straight you win \$1500 cash and if it hits backward, you win \$500. Each player is asked to sell 13 tickets. Tickets have been order and will be distributed soon. - Yeti / Booze Raffle: more information will be announced soon but we are going to hold a Yeti cooler raffle stuff with bottles of alcohol.
